


### Understanding God As He Is...

Exodus 34:6–7 (CSB) — 6 The LORD passed in front of him and proclaimed: The LORD—the LORD is a compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger and abounding in faithful love and truth, 7 maintaining faithful love to a thousand generations, forgiving iniquity, rebellion, and sin. But he will not leave the guilty unpunished, bringing the consequences of the fathers' iniquity on the children and grandchildren to the third and fourth generation.

#### Compassionate/merciful

**Psalm 78:38 (CSB)** — **38** Yet he was compassionate; he atoned for their iniquity and did not destroy them. He often turned his anger aside and did not unleash all his wrath.

#### Gracious



Exodus 32:9-10 (CSB) — 9 The LORD also said to Moses, "I have seen this people, and they are indeed a stiff-necked people. 10 Now leave me alone, so that my anger can burn against them and I can destroy them. Then I will make you into a great nation."

# Compassion & Grace at Sinai

Exodus 34:1 (CSB) The LORD said to Moses, "Cut two stone tablets like the first ones, and I will write on them the words that were on the first tablets, which you broke."




- God is not "uninterested" in us
- God's Compassion and Grace manifests itself in action
- God's Compassion and Grace is more valuable than man's

Exodus 33:19 (CSB) He said, "I will cause all my goodness to pass in front of you, and I will proclaim the name 'the LORD' before you. I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion."

Joel 2:12–13 (CSB) — 12 Even now— this is the LORD's declaration— turn to me with all your heart, with fasting, weeping, and mourning. 13 Tear your hearts, not just your clothes, and return to the LORD your God. For he is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger, abounding in faithful love, and he relents from sending disaster.

Jonah 3:10–4:2 (CSB) — 10 God saw their actions—that they had turned from their evil ways—so God relented from the disaster he had threatened them with. And he did not do it. 1 Jonah was greatly displeased and became furious....That's why I fled toward Tarshish in the first place. I knew that you are a gracious and compassionate God, slow to anger, abounding in faithful love, and one who relents from sending disaster.
